- 1986 (59th) *Children of a Lesser God* [Randa Haines was NOT nominated for directing]
- 1990 (63rd) *Awakenings* [Penny Marshall was NOT nominated for directing]
- 1991 (64th) *The Prince of Tides* [Barbra Streisand was NOT nominated for directing]
- 1993 (66th) *The Piano* [Jane Campion was nominated for directing]
- 2003 (76th) *Lost in Translation* [Sofia Coppola was nominated for directing]
- 2006 (79th) *Little Miss Sunshine* [Valerie Faris (and Jonathan Dayton) were NOT nominated for directing]

— Beginning with the 82nd Awards, the Best Picture category expanded to 10 nominations —

- 2009 (82nd) * *The Hurt Locker* [Kathryn Bigelow won for directing]
An Education [Lone Scherfig was NOT nominated for directing]
- 2010 (83rd) *The Kids Are All Right* [Lisa Cholodenko was NOT nominated for directing]
Winter's Bone [Debra Granik was NOT nominated for directing]

— Beginning with the 84th Awards, the Best Picture category can have between 5 and 10 nominations —

- 2012 (85th) *Zero Dark Thirty* [Kathryn Bigelow was NOT nominated for directing]
- 2014 (87th) *Selma* [Ava DuVernay was NOT nominated for directing]
